1) Guest Lecture on Goods & Service Tax (GST) (06/01/2018)

On 6th January, 2018 Department organized guest lecture on “Goods & Service Tax (GST). Miss. Gauri Kulkarni (Director, Business Development, Nilaya Group of Education, Pune) was the resource person for the programme. She gives brief introduction to various taxes applied to commerce & industries in India. Then she step by step explained the concept & process of GST. She also stated the benefits of GST to businessmen & to Government. She added that GST will be milestone in development of Indian Taxation System. She also highlighted demerits of GST.

Total 85 students of B.com II & B.Com III were participated in this programme. Prin. Dr. M.B. Waghmode was the chairperson for the programme. Mr. Amey Desai introduced the programme & Mr. Nalawade S.V. expressed vote of thanks.

2) One Day Workshop on Consumer Guidance & Financial Literacy (11/01/2018)

He delivered an expert speech on “An Introduction to Indian Banking System”. He briefly introduced the evolution of Indian banking system & various types of banks with their functions. He explained the history of Nationalization of Banks. He elaborated the need & benefits of Nationalization of Banks in 1969. He also guided students about core banking system adopted by banks. He highlighted changing functions of banks with practical examples. Prin. Dr. M.B. Waghmode was the chairperson for this programme. Prof. Desai A.A. introduced the theme of Commerce Day and Prof. Nalavade S. V. expressed vote of thanks.

Commerce Day is a bunch of various activities. Following activities were conducted on this occasion-
