1) One Day Workshop on Soft Skill Development for Careers in Management (19/09/2018)

On 19th September, 2018 Department organized one day workshop on “Soft Skill Development for Careers in Management”. Miss. Gauri Kulkarni (Director, Business Development, Nilaya Group of Education, Pune) & Mr. Santosh Mundhe (Technical Associate) was the resource person for the programme. Miss. Gauri Kulkarni gives brief introduction to different soft & hard skills. Then she step by step explained various soft skills. She also stated the importance of soft skills in professional as well as in personal life.

2) Guest Lecture on “Me Udyojak kasa zalo” (How I became an Entrepreneur) (12/01/2019)

On 12th January, 2019 Department organized guest lecture on “Me Udyojak kasa zalo” (How I became an Entrepreneur) in collaboration with Jivanmitra Foundation, Medha. Mr. Vijay Sawale (Founder, VSM Medico Company, Mumbai) was the resource person for the program. He delivered lecture on Mi Udyojak kasa zalo (How I became an Entrepreneur). He explored his journey of becoming an entrepreneur from the beginning. He stated that his family’s financial condition was not so good so he left his village and went to Mumbai for finding job. He struggled to get his first job at medical store. Then he actively learned everything in medical store. After getting proper experience in medical field, he started his own firm with small capital. He worked hard and developed his business. He highlighted qualities of successful entrepreneur. He stated that discipline and continuous hard work is key to success.

3) Three days workshop on Entrepreneurship Awareness (17th to 19th January, 2019)

Department of Commerce in collaboration with Placement cell and SVS IMCON, Satara organized 3 day workshop on Entrepreneurship Awareness from 17th January, 2019 to 19th January, 2019. The Workshop aimed to provide opportunities to the undergraduate students to enrich their entrepreneur development skills in starting a business. The Workshop also intended to develop the knowledge among the commerce and arts students as how to be an entrepreneur at the initial stages of their career.

On first day of workshop Mr. Dilip Prabhune guided students about Entrepreneur, Entrepreneurship – Historical background and present scenario in first session. In second session Mrs. Prachi Shinde guided participants about Identification of Business opportunities and Mechanism of product selection.

On second day Mr. Dilip Prabhune guided students on identification of Business opportunities and Mechanism of product selection in session I and in session II Mr. Uday Lokhande guided participants about How to start a SSI unit (General concept about the Govt. formalities, rules & regulation, location, and different aspect of an industrial venture.)

One third day of workshop Mr. Dilip Prabhune guided participants on Scheme of assistance and Support available From Govt. agencies, banks, financial institutions, SFCs etc. in his first session. 4) Guest Lecture on Career Opportunities in Management (19/01/2019)

to the participants and assured them that the society will help them in any consumer rights related issues.
