Department of Commerce organized various programs and activities for the commerce students in academic year 2019-20.

1. MoU with Consumer Guidance Society of India (CGSI) (01/01/2020)

On 1st January, 2020 Department of commerce signed MoU with Consumer Guidance Society of India (CGSI). It is decided that the Consumer Guidance Society of India will conduct one day workshop on financial literacy and consumer guidance every year. It will provide resource persons and financial support for the workshop. The college will provide all necessary arrangements like hall, projector etc to organize the workshop. It was also decided that Mr. Amey Desai will work as coordinator for this MoU and workshop.

2. One Day Workshop on Employment Enhancement Skills (08/12/2020)

On 8th January, 2020 department of commerce organized one day workshop on "Employment Enhancement Skills". Dr. Sarang Bhola (Associate Professor, KBP Institute of Management) and Dr. M.B. Bhosale (Director, KBP Institute of Management) was the resource person for the program.

Dr. Sarang Bhola introduced the concept of Employment Enhancement. He explained various employment enhancement skills. He highlighted the importance of these skills. In second session Dr. M.B. Bhosale explained need of employment enhancement skills in the era of cut throat competition. He described necessary soft skills for getting better job. He urged students to be well equipped with various soft skills.
