Various subjects related to Employment & Self employment for students were discussed in the meeting and following activities are finalized to be taken in the academic year 2018-19

- 1) To send students to campus interviews organized by various colleges
- 2) To Guide Students about Interview Techniques.
- 3) To Arrange One day workshop on Entrepreneurship Skill Development for students
- 4) To start Competitive examination centre for new academic year.
- 5) To arrange Guest Lecture on Career opportunities after Graduation.

As per the decisions and plan confirmed in meeting Employment & Self Employment Centre, Amdar Shashikant Shinde Mahavidyalaya, Medha has arranged following activities in academic year 2018-19.

1) Guest Lecture on "Career in Competitive Examinations" (14/08/2018)

On August 14, Placement cell and Competitive Examination guidance center was inaugurated. The chief guest in front of DySP.Mr. Ajit Tike Saheb's. In the introduction Dr.Sudhir Nagarkar, coordinator librarian of the competitive examination department said that in the age of competition there is no option without competitive examination. The competitive examination center is trying to make Javali taluka an administrative authority taluka instead of a mathadi's taluka, also the visitors should keep their knowledge up to date by using internet and the visitors were welcomed.

The Chief Guest for the event - Guide Wai Police Station DYSP. He said that the first four minutes after an accident are important and he also informed about the care to be taken in that accident. He explained that there are three causes of fire, and guided the students on what to do to prevent it. Pankaj Mankar guided the students about how to take care of a person if he is burnt. He showed the demo of how to put out the fire. The speakers informed the students about the different courses in Fire & Safety and where there are job opportunities after completing the courses.

3) One Day Workshop on Soft Skill Development for Careers in Management (19/09/2018)

He worked hard and developed his business. He highlighted qualities of successful entrepreneur. He stated that discipline and continuous hard work is key to success.

5) Three days workshop on Entrepreneurship Awareness (17th to 19th January, 2019)

Department of Commerce in collaboration with Placement cell and SVS IMCON, Satara organized 3 day workshop on Entrepreneurship Awareness from 17th January, 2019 to 19th January, 2019. The Workshop aimed to provide opportunities to the undergraduate students to enrich their entrepreneur development skills in starting a business. The Workshop also intended to develop the knowledge among the commerce and arts students as how to be an entrepreneur at the initial stages of their career.

On first day of workshop Mr. Dilip Prabhune guided students about Entrepreneur, Entrepreneurship – Historical background and present scenario in first session. In second session Mrs. Prachi Shinde guided participants about Identification of Business opportunities and Mechanism of product selection.

On second day Mr. Dilip Prabhune guided students on identification of Business opportunities and Mechanism of product selection in session I and in session II Mr. Uday Lokhande guided participants about How to start a SSI unit (General concept about the Govt. formalities, rules & regulation, location, and different aspect of an industrial venture.)
