#### **1) Guest Lecture on Opportunities in Higher Education (22/08/2022)**

On 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2022 Department organized guest lecture on “Opportunities in Higher Education”. Mrs. Sampada Mane (Assistant Professor, Yaswantrao Chavan School of Social Work, Satara) was the resource person for the programme. At the beginning of the lecture Mrs. Sampada Mane explained the need and importance of higher education. She elaborated various higher education opportunities for commerce and arts graduates.
