

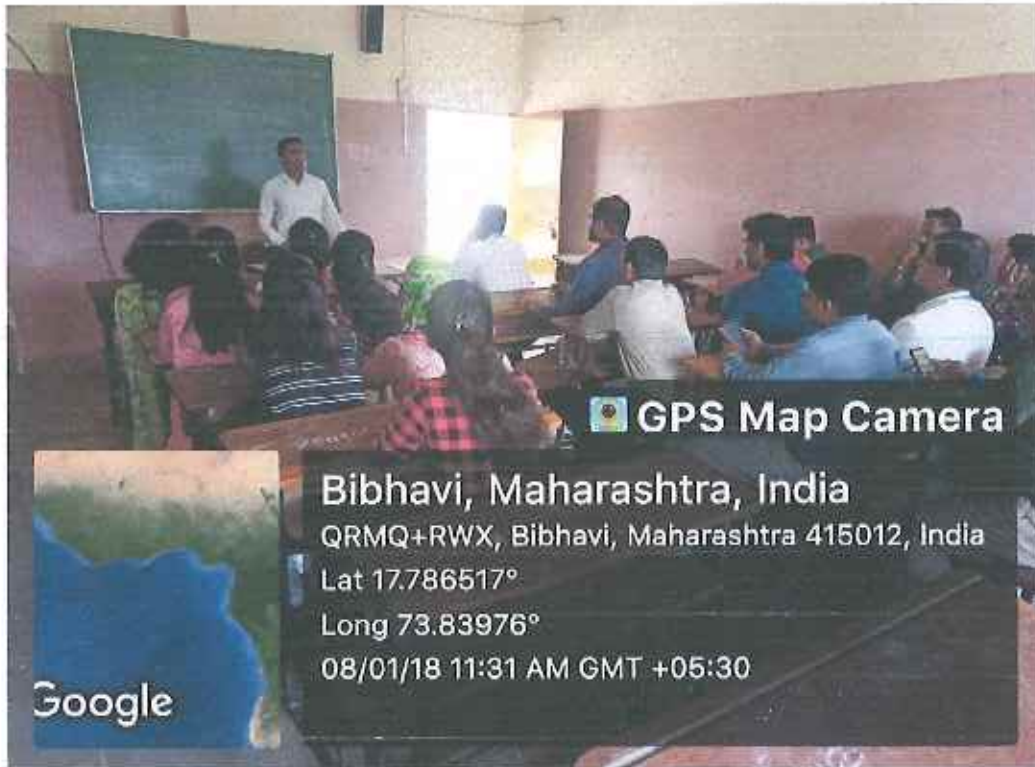

To spread awareness, need and importance of IPR among, Staff Academy, Amdar Shashikant Shinde Mahavidyalaya, Medha organized a One Day Seminar on IPR Awareness on 08th January, 2018 at 11.00 am in Audio Visual Hall. The whole lecture was anchored by Dhanawade Damini and Aishwarya Aglave T. Y. B. Sc. Botany Students.

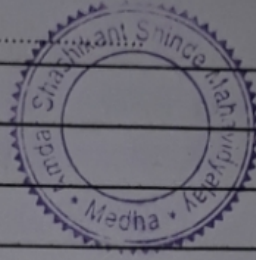


