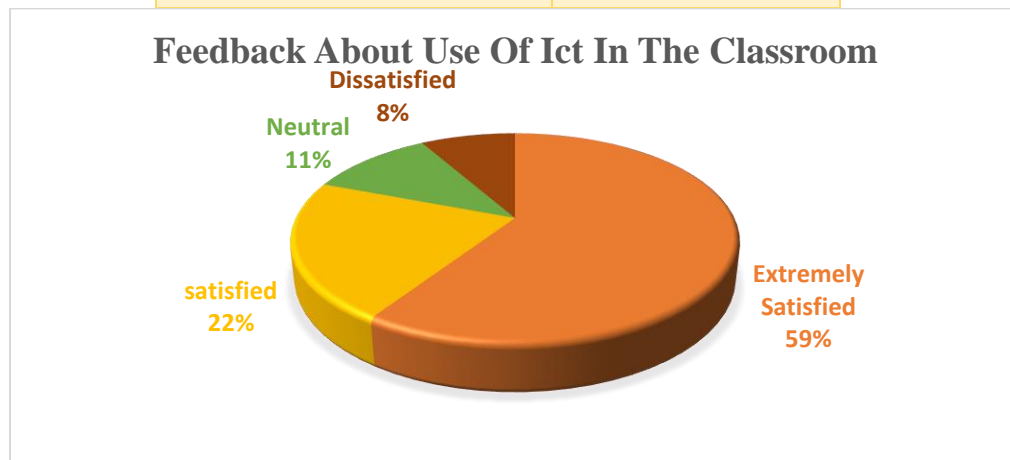

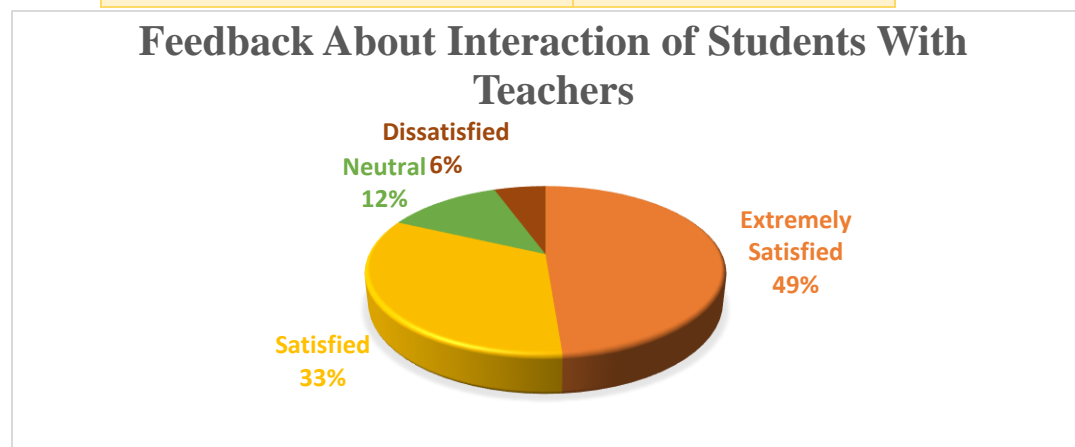

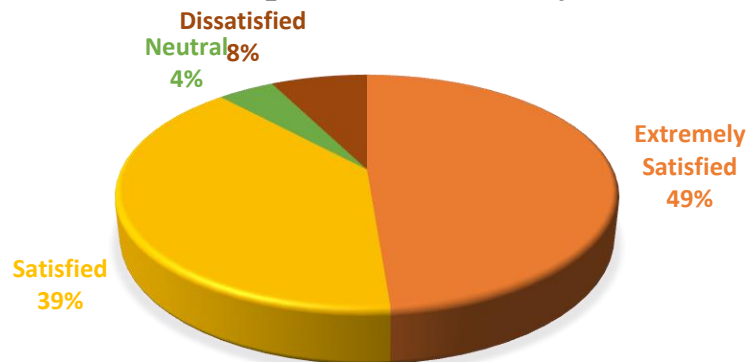

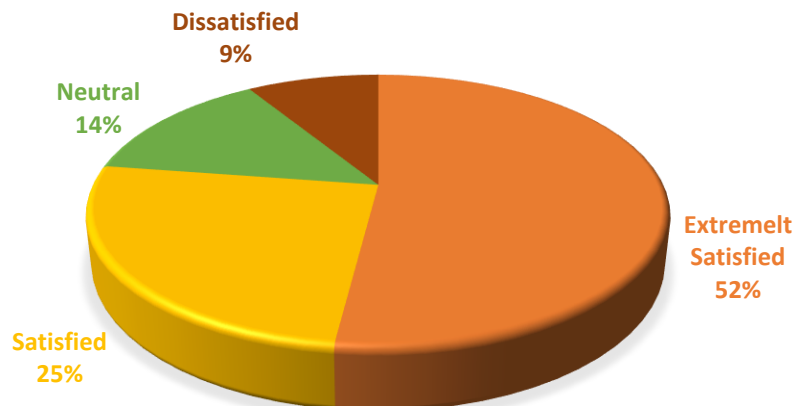

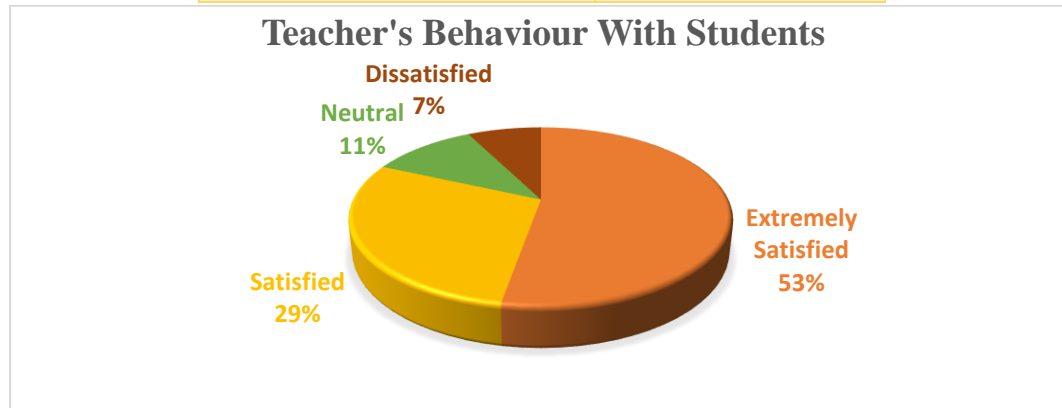

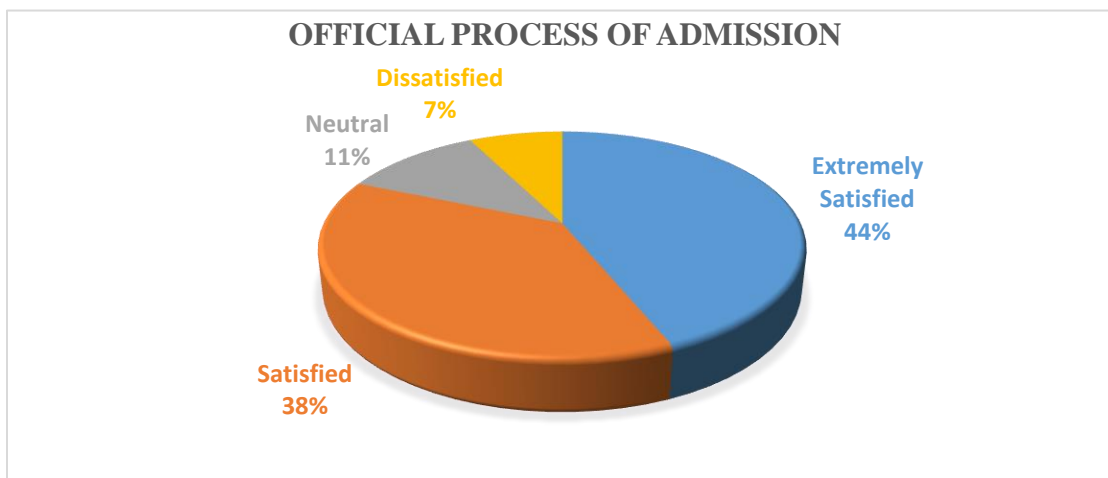

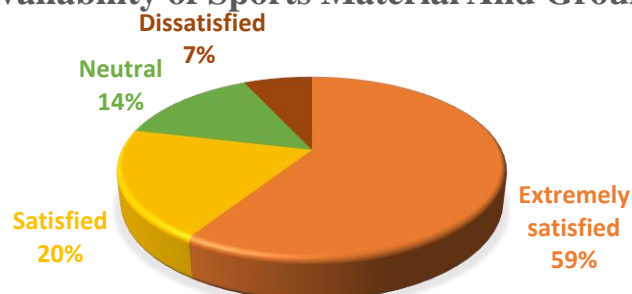

Availability of Sports Material And Grounds



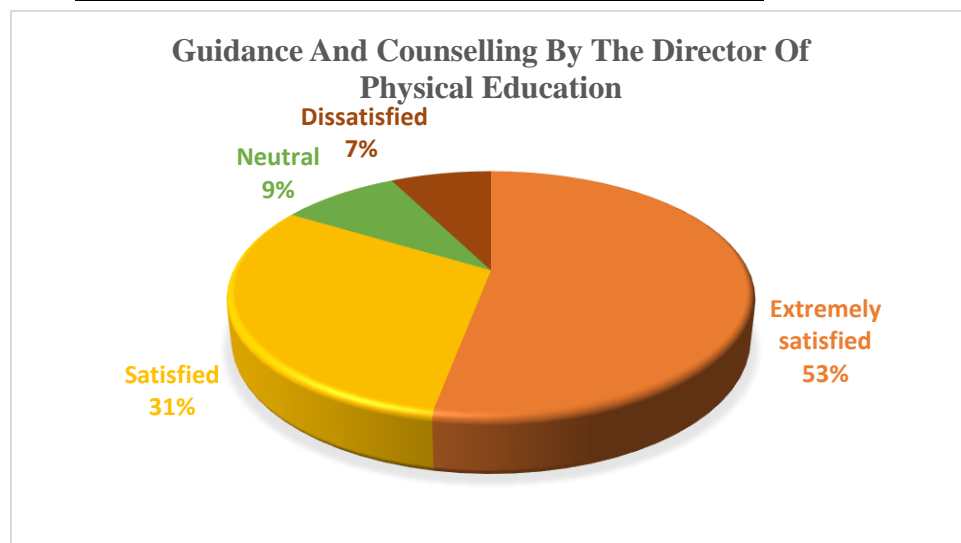

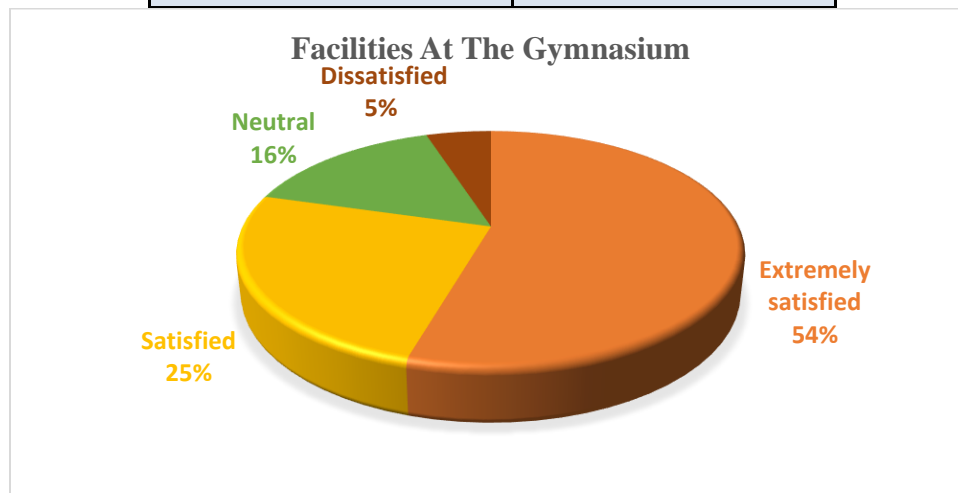

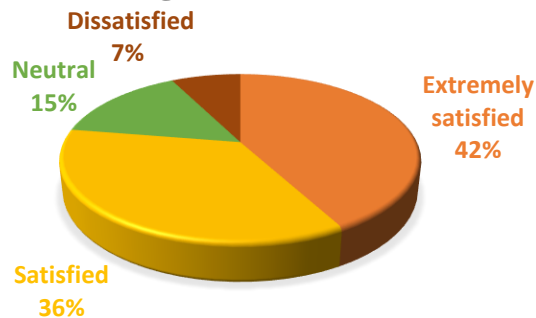

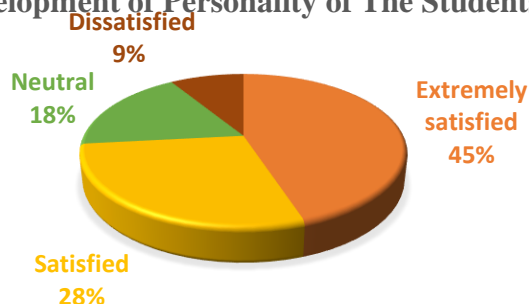

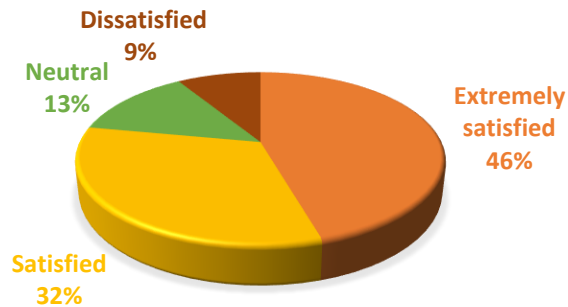

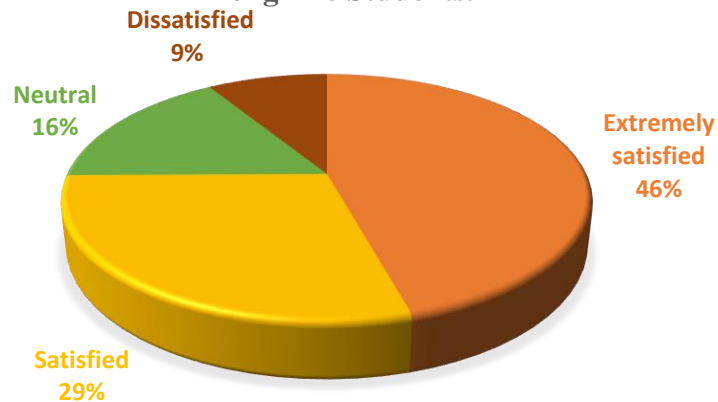

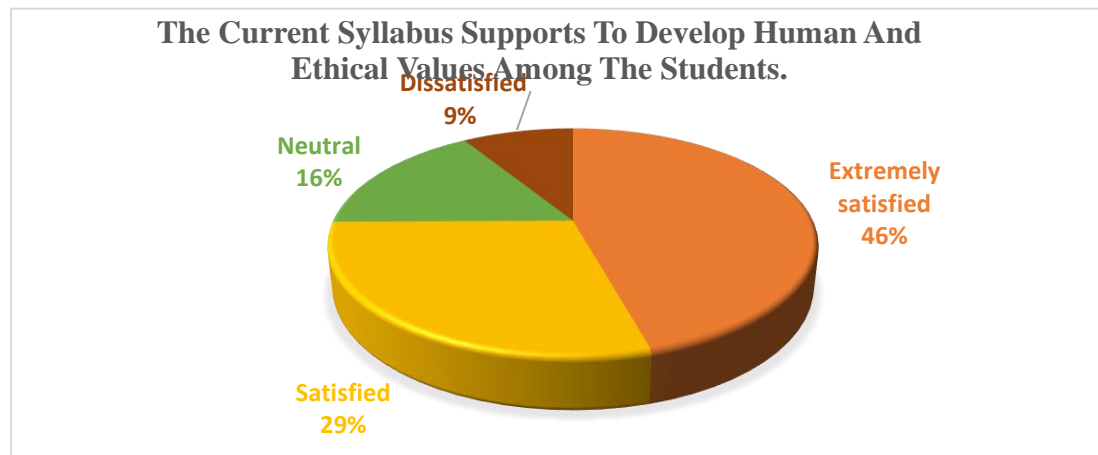

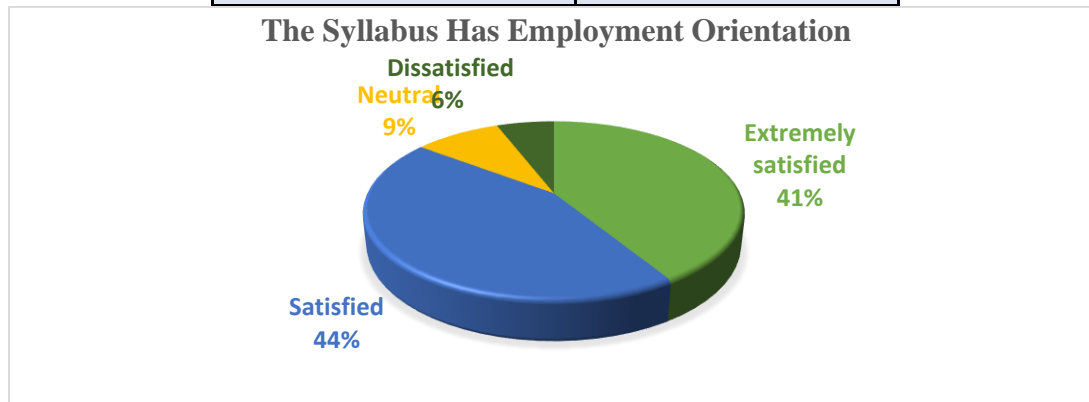

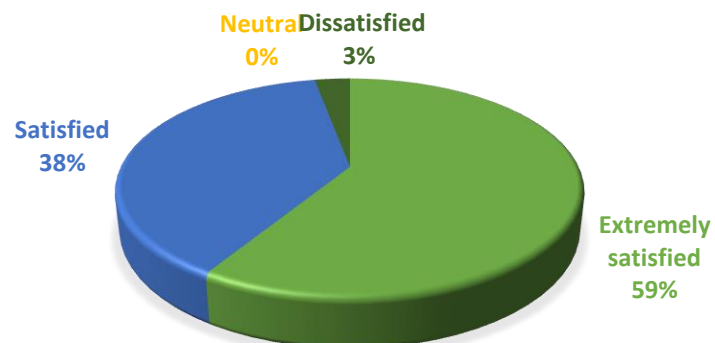

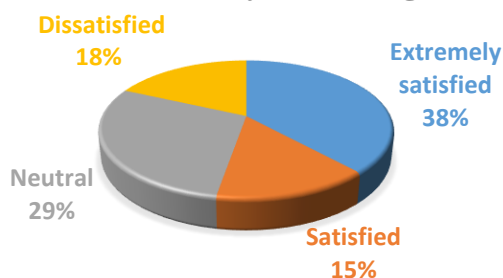

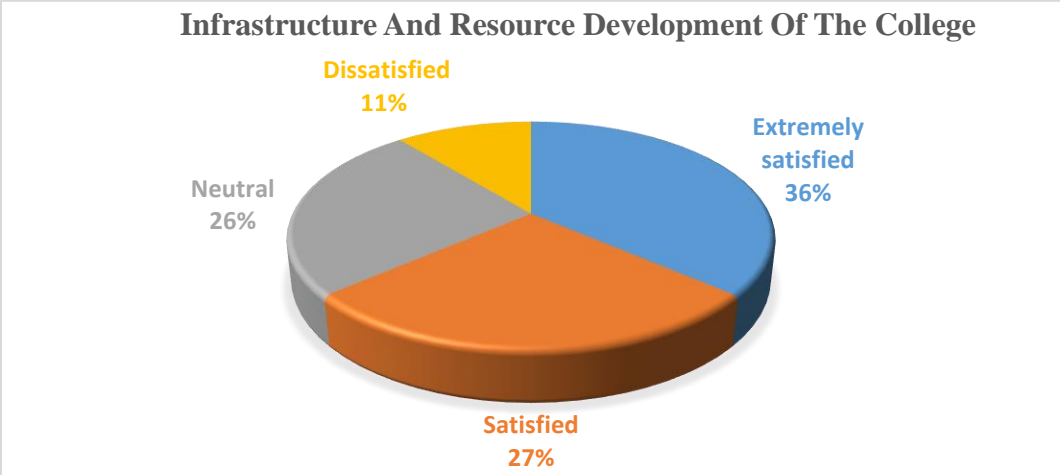

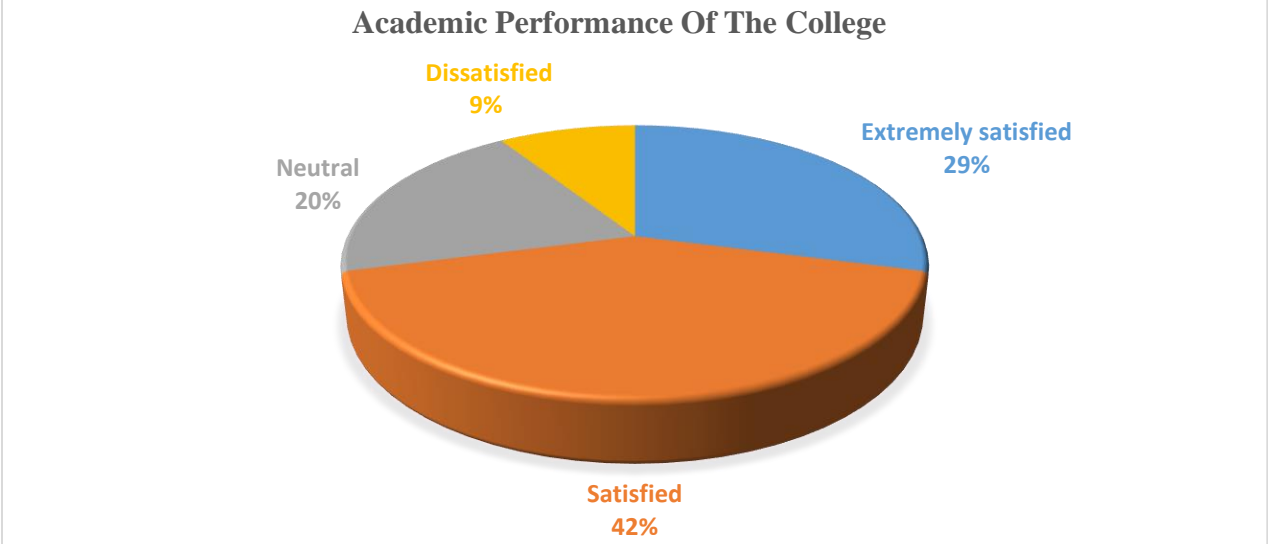

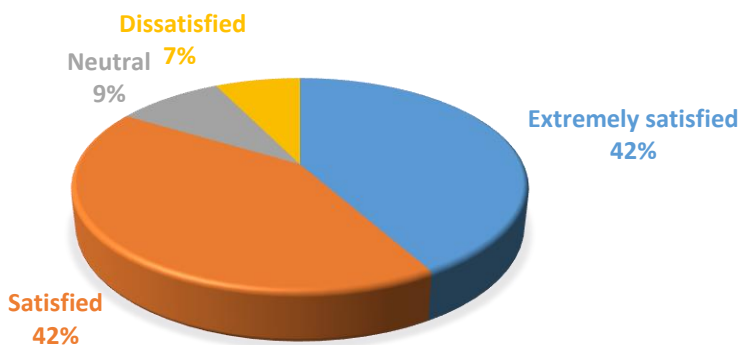

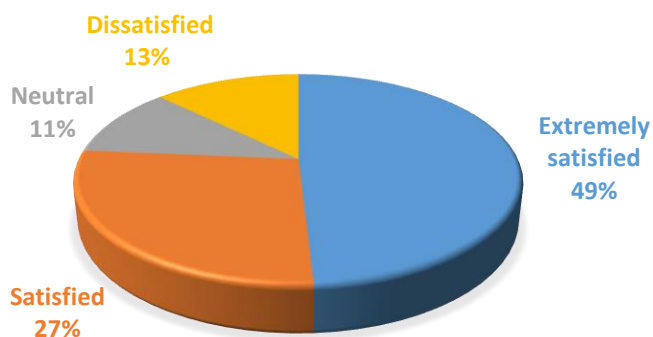
Opinion About The Adequacy Of The Present Curriculam Of Various Courses

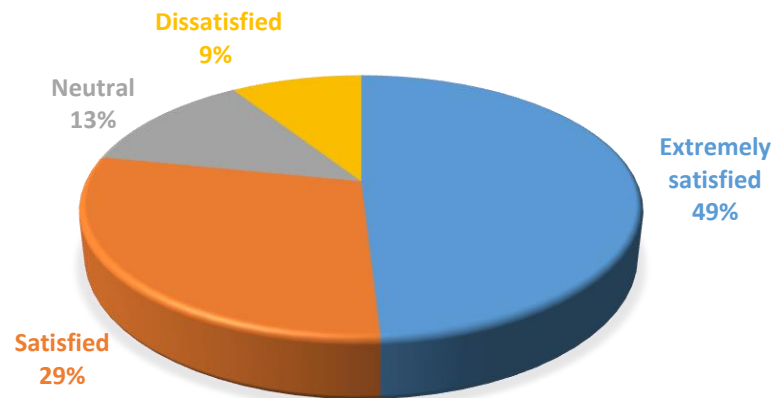

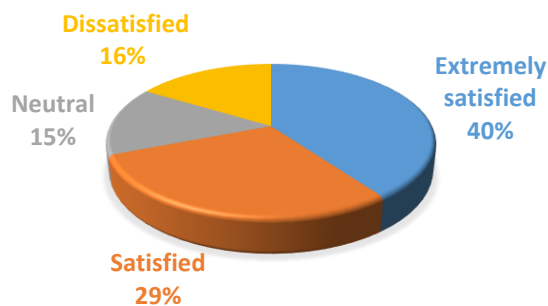

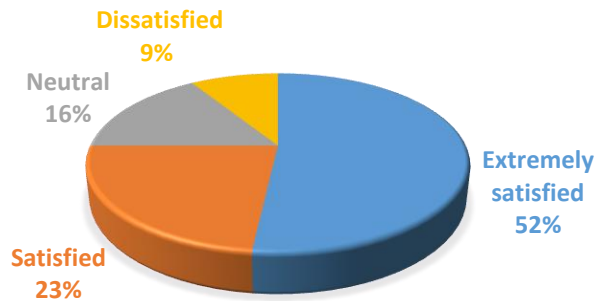

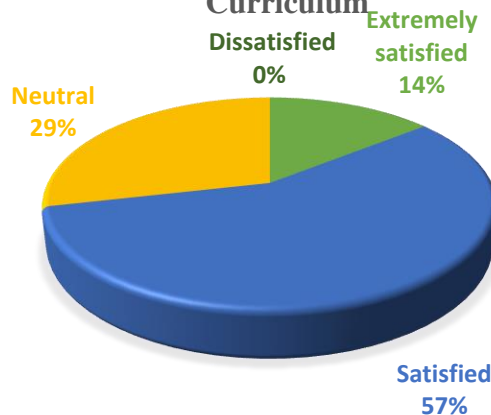

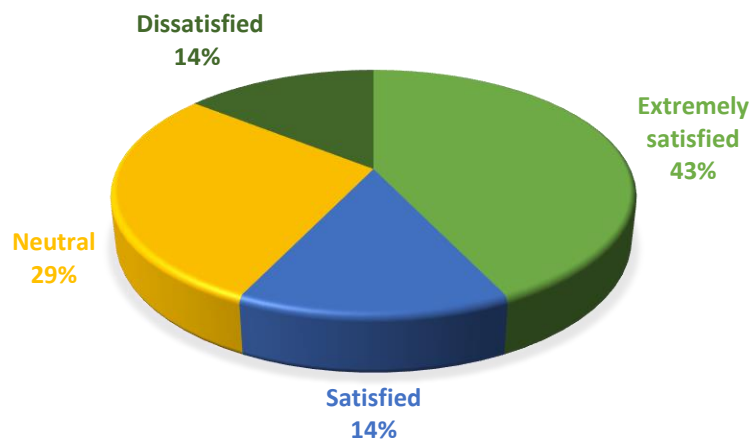

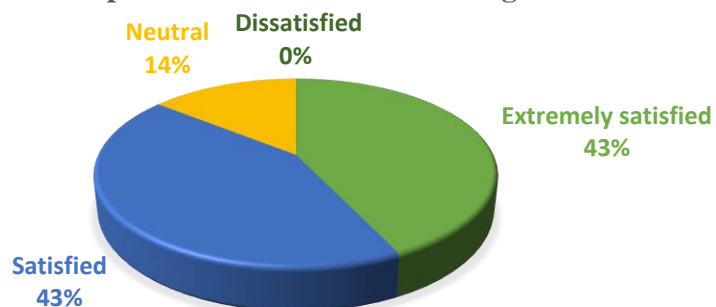

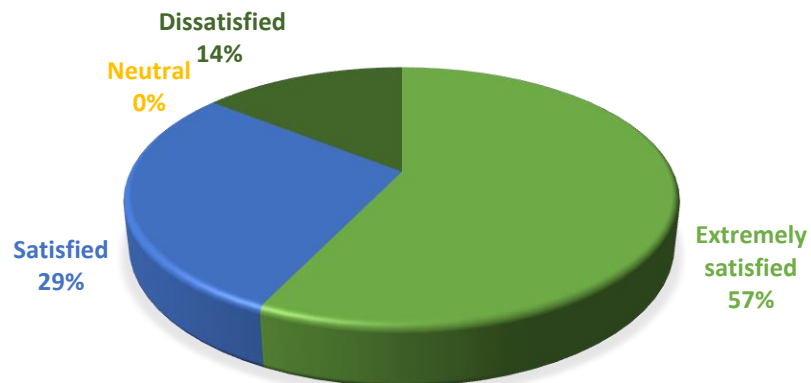

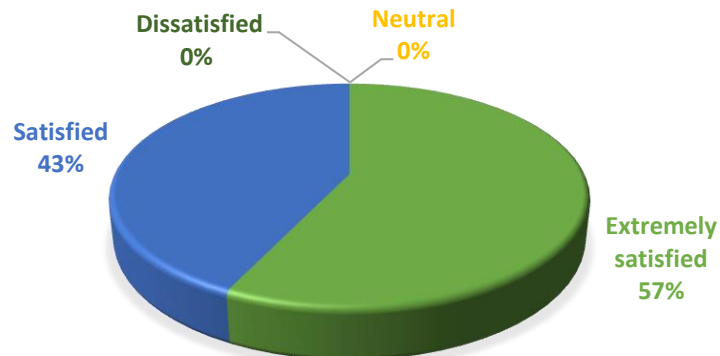

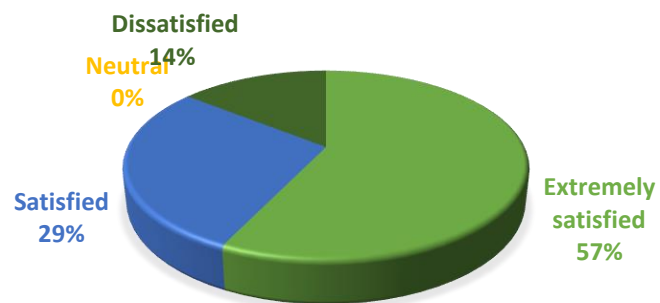

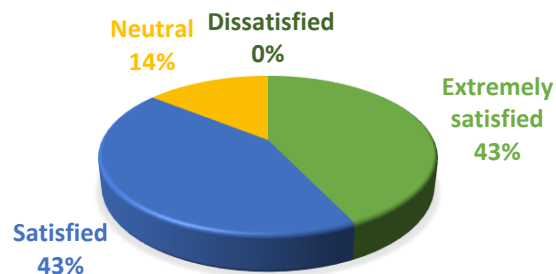

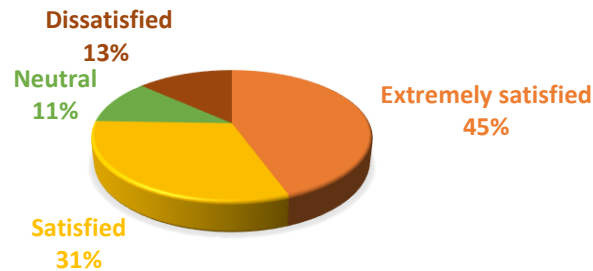

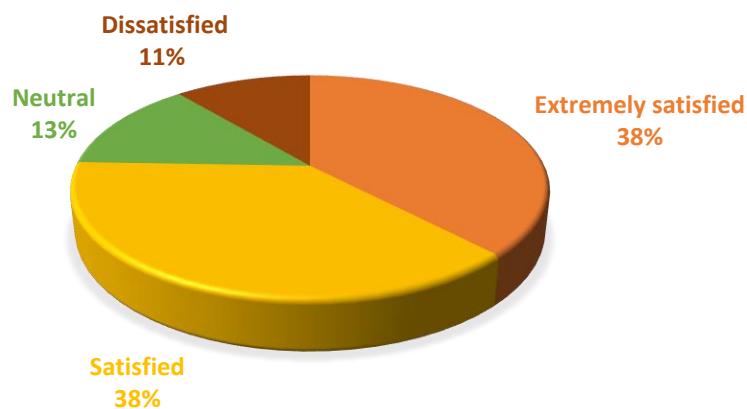

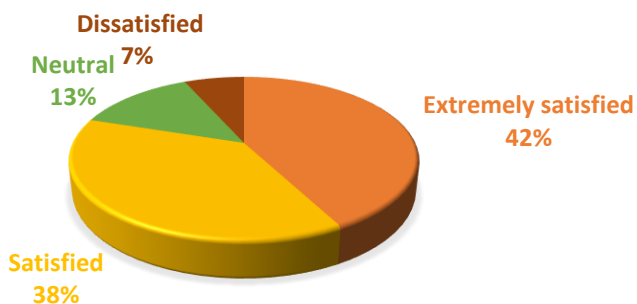

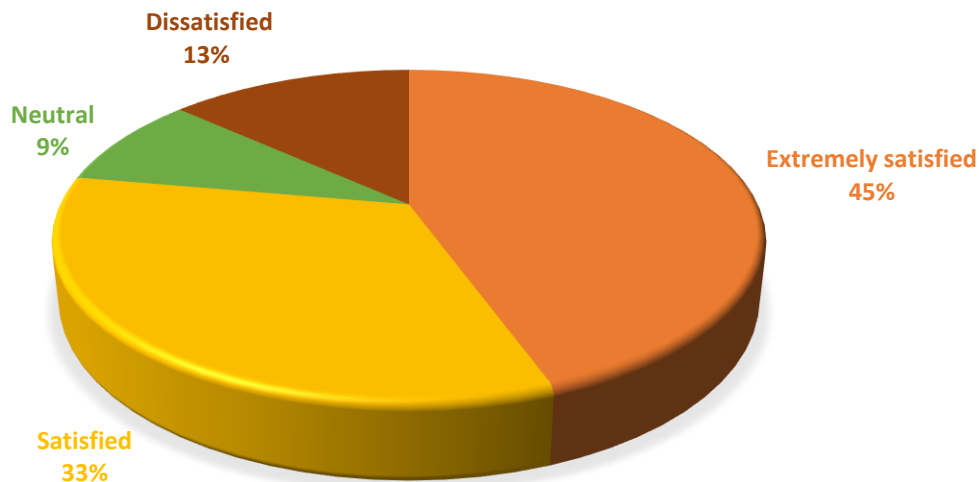

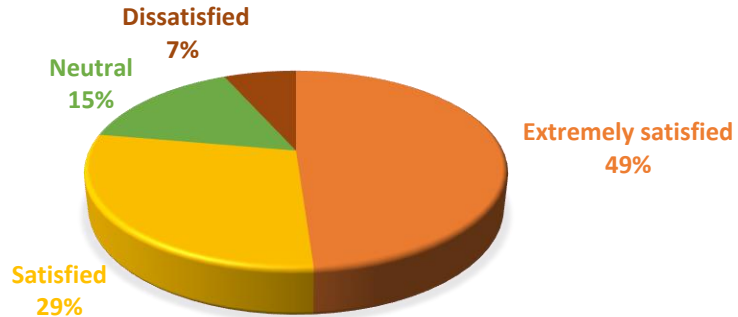

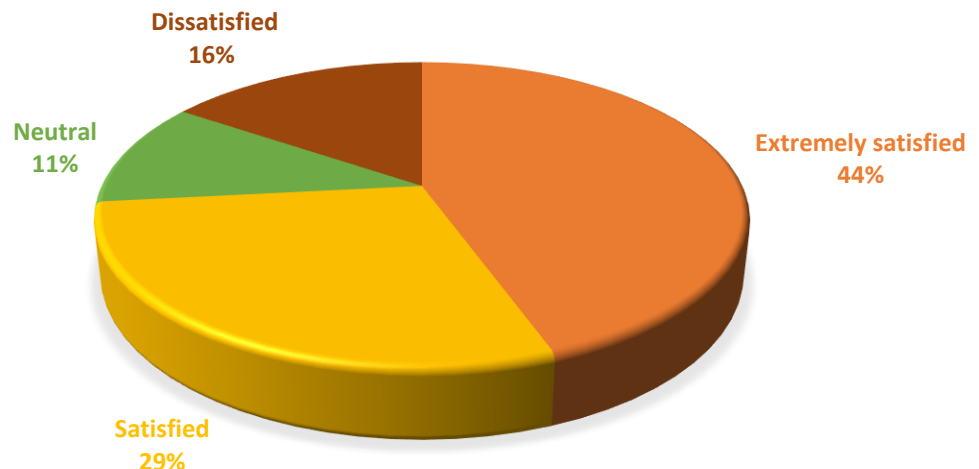

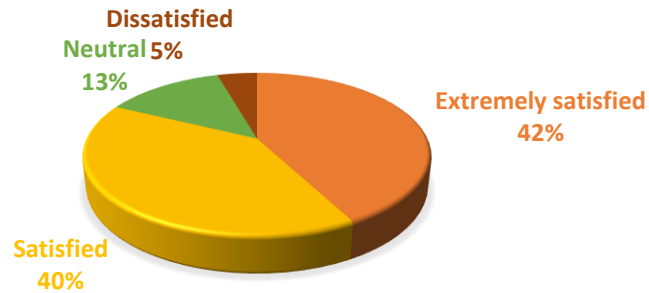
